Other Evidence relating to Shakespeare



12th January 1598, bill of sale. Wyllyn Wyatt Chamberlin "Pd to Mr. Shakespere for one load of stone xd".

4th February 1598, list of Hoarders. Shakspere is named as having illegally held 10 quarters (80 bushels) of malt or corn during a shortage. (Shakespeare Birthplace Trust Records Office, Misc. Doc. I, 106.)

25th March 1601 Will of Thomas Whittington:

"Item I geve and bequeth unto the poore people of Stratford 40s that is in the hand of Anne Shaxspere, wyf unto Mr. Wyllyam Shaxspere, and is due debt unto me...". (Worcestershire Record Office.)
